THE AIMS OF YOUR ONLINE SAFETY PROGRAMME AND HOW IT LINKS TO OFSTED FRAMEWORK



DIGITAL LITERACY:

Develop **digital literacy** for your young people, including **digital citizenship**: understanding what behaviours are acceptable online and how to contribute to a positive online environment where everyone feels able to participate. As well as **digital resilience**: building the personal emotional resources needed to understand online risks, knowing what to do to seek help, learning from experience and recovering when things go wrong.



CURRICULUM INCLUSION:

Integrating digital literacy and citizenship into your school curriculum. Designed to ensure that your pupils understand how to conduct themselves online in a safe and appropriate manner. Our creative activities allow learning about emotional health and relationships both online and offline to be an enjoyable experience. Allowing your young people to be **confident, self-assured learners**.



EFFECTIVE STAFF DEVELOPMENT:

Provide your teachers with knowledge of the dangers and risks associated with the use of technology, including bullying, grooming, sexting, and radicalisation. Understanding what publicly available online content could pose a threat to or influence children, including how to spot trending online issues reported through the press. Allowing a place for them to **reflect on and debate the way they teach** 'Online Safety'.



ROBUST REPORTING:

Work with your school to create a reporting stream that works for your schools. Allowing **action to be taken immediately** if there are any concerns about potential online bullying or inappropriate behaviour. **Developing a strategy for reporting** and intelligence gathering developed with and for staff to ensure that any necessary interventions are carried out to protect the safety of pupils in their care.

KS3 SCHOOLS ONLINE CHALLENGE DAY PACKAGE

Whole KS3 take over, with our expert Online Safety Challenge team. Over 3 days we will visit your Year7,8 & 9 pupils, challenging your schools online safety knowledge with our jam-packed online safety day.

The below activities will be host three times over three days, with a day dedicated to each of your KS3 year groups:

- **Assembly:** Starting the day with a challenge setting assembly in your hall for the chosen year group.
- **Lesson based challenges:** Each class/tutor group will be set their own challenges they must complete with their set teachers. Linking online safety to your schools core subjects with cross curriculum links.
- **Online Safety Champion Training:** Online Safety Challenge team will work with a group of your children selected by your ICT lead (suggested up to 10), training them to be Online Safety Champions. The champions will gain the tools to become ambassadors for your school. Developing their Knowledge of Online Safety, alongside the skills to present and be peer mentors, will ensure their learning is cascaded down throughout the school.

SCHOOL STAFF CREATIVE TRAINING

Creative and engaging training sessions that will allow your staff to **feel confident** discussing online safety concerns with your young people and able to detect **safeguarding** concerns; from dinner ladies to your senior leadership team, this training will allow them to reflect on and debate the way they teach 'Online Safety'.

Facilitators from Unique Voice will host a creative 1.5 hour input for all staff in Online Safety messages including cross curriculum approaches to online safety. The training will explore the following themes;

- Apps and online features; their dangers, risks and relevance to young people
- Tips and support in embedding Online Safety across the school community
- Creative approaches to raising awareness of Online Safety through campaigns, assemblies and lessons
- Resources for further guidance and support
