Privacy Policy

Online Programmes

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which the Company collects, uses, maintains and discloses information collected from users of the Company. This Privacy Policy applies to the Company and all programmes offered by the Company.

Personal identification information

We may collect personal identification information from authorised users in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when users access any company programme, subscribe to a newsletter, and in connection with other activities, services, features, or resources we make available in our Company. Users may visit the programme anonymously. We will collect personal identification information from users only if they voluntarily submit such information to us. Users can refuse to supply personal identification information but doing so may prevent them from engaging in certain Company related activities.

Information collected on registration

In order to register you on our programmes we may collect your name, your role at your school/ place of work, a work email address, a generic office email address and the postal/delivery and billing addresses and telephone number of the school/college/place of work. We do not request personal information such as home addresses, personal email addresses or telephone numbers for registration purposes; however, if you choose to submit these the information will be treated in line with this privacy policy and general GDPR guidelines.

We maintain records of the products and services you/your school has purchased and the results of any of our questionnaires, surveys and quality assurance checks that you may have taken part in.

How we use collected information

The Company may collect and use Users' personal identification information for the following purposes:

- We may use information in the aggregate to understand how our Users as a group use the services and resources provided in our Company.
- *To send periodic emails*

We do not sell, trade, or rent User personal identification information to others.
